Who can nominate?

Guidance counselors, school principals, and gifted education teachers are certified to nominate students.

How do I know which students can be nominated?

- Students may be nominated who have completed the 7th, 8th or 9th grade at the conclusion of the current academic year
- Students who are high achievers as indicated by GPA, IQ, high standardized test scores, enrollment in gifted courses, or equivalent measurement.
